The Sista Nonprofit Network (SNN) is a growing online community for Black women in the nonprofit and philanthropic sectors. The network, created by Black women in nonprofit and philanthropy, is a professional safe space for Black women in these sectors for relationship building professional and development. SNN members are Black women in a diversity of roles, at various careers stages early career to senior level, at nonprofit and philanthropic organizations. The network has over 250 members that live and work in over 66 different cities in the United States and internationally.

  - 5 Sista Roundtables-space to discusss workplace environments and issues
- Over 50 Black women nonprofit and philanthropic leaders have served as speakers for network events
- Over 211 members have joined our private LinkedIn Group
